- Contribute to the interface Risk and Opportunity identification and mitigation, coordinating with the relevant HPC site stakeholders (Construction Delivery Team,...), with an attendance at HPC Site at a frequency appropriate to oversee delivery.
- Support improving current tools and processes,
- Report weekly progress.
